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## MESSAGE OF THE WCBO DIRECTOR

When I think of my experience working as a Project Director/Founder Member at CHEYUTHA WCBO, it makes me pretty Nostalgic!! Ridges and furrows have been extremely common in the lives of HIV infected people as well as myself when I have been encountered to address, behold and face, finally the myriad Challenges in the Day to Day lives of a Vulnerable Community.



The Impacts of the so called, “Scare” has resulted to a major Challenge with regards to Fund Raising. On one hand, where the Corporate Social Responsibility Departments from multiple Organizations faced a major Financial Setback, it was no less that the Discrimination of HIV people also added more to the story. Above all, bulk of the HIV infected people come from the Lower class section of the society with the least extent of Awareness, Literacy and the urge to live a Fulfilled life of Worth and Dignity. Adding to these shortcomings, the Self Esteem of maximum of the HIV infected people goes extremely Low. They have a sense of Disappointment at every corner of their lives because of the Social impediments.


Along with my experiences being a Project Director/Founder Member, I commenced with the Process of Exploring more and more amongst the HIV infected Kids and Children. Moreover, in the last two decades, I have been successful partially that the new Generation of HIV Infected children are having a Positive Vision towards life. Furthermore, I am always in the Mission of pooling out the next Level of Second Line Leaders from this clan, who could be elected as a Naïve Generation of Board Members for CHEYUTHA WCBO. At the same time, with the valued contributions of profuse Philanthropists and Generous Donors, I feel blessed personally that I have been able to continue successfully with the Adolescent Friendly Health Clinic (AFHC) Camps every once a month. On one hand, we have meaningful Sessions of Life Skills and Personality Development, a Vital Session on “GOOD TOUCH and BAD TOUCH” to the HIV Infected children, Training Session to HIV infected Adolescent Girls and Women on Menstruation Hygiene.

As a Project Director/Founder Member, I am also concentrating on two specific parameters. Firstly, it has become my 360 Degrees Goal to advise the HIV Infected Parents to keep a limit on their Family Planning Structure, thereby limiting the number of children. Secondly, I also dream of CHEYUTHA WCBO of having Plethora Affiliations, such as the Telangana State.

In order to live and lead a Life of Dignity and Respect, CHEYUTHA WCBO has come up with this Trendsetting Project of making quiet a number of HIV Infected Women get trained in Tailoring of Jute Bags. As of now, the WCBO has been able to train a group of Ten HIV infected women, as a result, making them feel the essence of Working and Living with extreme Respect in a Stigmatized Society. Adding to the Facts, I feel extremely ecstatic to convey that these women have been able to fetch a source of Regular Income, along with a boost in their Confidence levels to Live for the Best from the Better.

Well, I ask myself whether where are the Core challenges I am facing?. On one hand, presently, CHEYUTHA WCBO is able to get very Less Funding. On the other hand, the rate of per Jute Bag being paid to our Women Tailors is extremely menial. This in fact, is very Disheartening !! Adding to this, we are also facing a Couple of Operational Challenges when it comes to the Consumption of Electricity and the purchase of the Jute Material from the National Jute Board.

Concluding this part of my message to many of my Allies, I dream of a Vision, wherein, I find a vibrant Team of Second Line Leaders onto the Board. In addition, I wish to behold a day when our own HIV infected children should not be the victims of Suicidal Tendencies and live a Healthy Mental Set up. Apart from this, I also visualize a day when our own HIV infected People are more and more responsible enough not to spread the Virus randomly amidst Non HIV People. Would all of you cooperate with me as A Team? I would be extremely Grateful to each and every Supporting Hand.

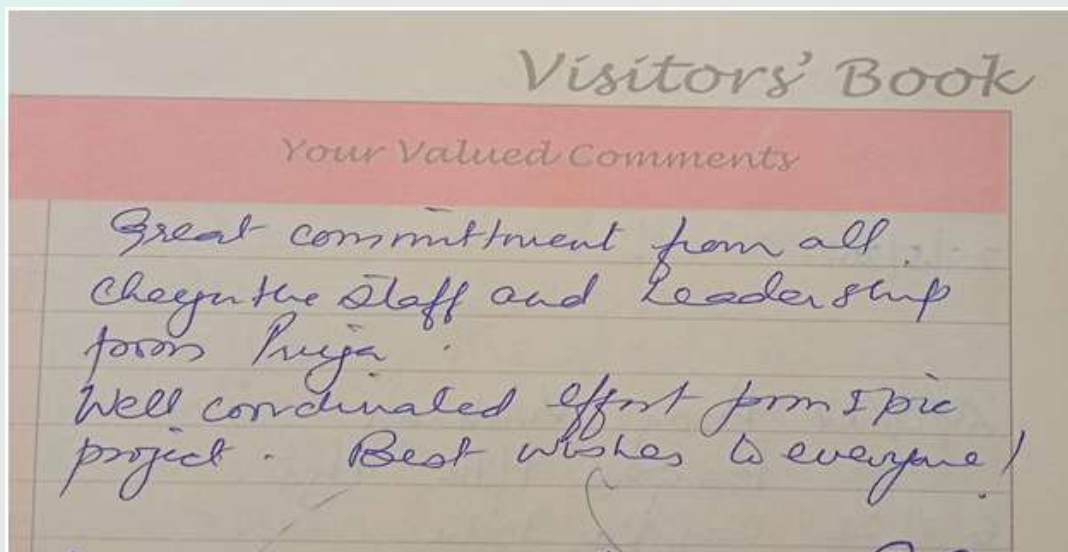

## STATUS OF VARIOUS PROJECTS

### A) AZIM PREMJI PHILANTHROPIST FOUNDATION

Cheyutha WCBO is extremely glad to assert on the fact that it has been receiving Funds from Azim Prem Ji Foundation and the plenary Management of Cheyutha WCBO has been using the Funds in the Right direction. On one hand, these Funds have been used for Induction Training for Board Members and on the other hand, these have also been used for the Program Management Trainings. Commencing from delivering the transparent picture on the Roles and Responsibilities of the Board Members, the story does not end here, because, it also included the proper Channels, whether how to impart the Right Direction on the Right Platform for the smooth operations of a WCBO. Moreover, there has been an extreme Transparency and additional Inputs delivered when it comes to the Standardization of the Documentation Process and also the Policy Making they also provide financial support for care and support services.

### AZIM PREMJI PHILANTHROPIC FOUNDATION LEARNING WORKSHOP TO CHEYUTHA WCBO

The team has interacted with the staff, Board Members, Support group members, Volunteers and enquired the functioning and systems in place ,whether how the WCBO is going in the Right Direction on the Right Platform for the smooth operations of a WCBO. They had enquired about the Transparency and Documentation Process and suggested for improvements/ standardization. The team has also visited the field to have first hand experience of the situations in the field. The team has appreciated the work of the WCBO.



The Learning Workshop by APPI team was of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of May, 2022. It has interacted with the Support Group Volunteers, Staff Members and Board Members and also the Second Line Leaders. The Team understood the Challenges being faced by Cheyutha WCBO. The team also shared their valuable Inputs.



## ORGANIZATION DEVELOPMENT TRAINING:

Induction training to Board members was conducted by Mr. Sree Ram as a Consultant for Organizational Development during 26th, 27th & 28th October 2022



CHEYUTHA WCBO has invited Mr. Sree Ram from Mysore as consultant to take up 3 days Induction training to Board members on the Importance of Organizational Development in community based organizations. All the Board members have taken active participation in the 3 day programme and interacted with the consultant. A number of doubts and clarifications were discussed and cleared during the training programme. The difference between a CBO and an NGO, Different types of management techniques, various policies to run the organization, staff structure, planning monitoring and review systems, financial planning and Audit were thoroughly discussed and understood

**B) ADP CSR SUPPORT TO CHILDREN:** AUTOMATIC DATA PROCESSING is a CSR corporate has been supporting since from 2021 mainly supporting for Infected and Affected children who are HIV Positive who are dependent on the Caregivers and Single Parents. ADP is much kind enough to take care of their Nutrition support, Medical needs and Education to 50 Children HIV Infected and Affected which resembled in the growth of height, weight and continuation of their studies.



### **VALUE LABS, HYDERABAD SUPPORT TO FOSTER CARE:**

The CSR Wing of VALUE LABS, Hyderabad has come forward to support 15 children since from 2016 by supplying them with Nutrition kits-needs. The support will be given to Orphan, Infected and Affected children; this will help them to take nutritious food at regular intervals which is very much needed during ART treatment and which helps them in increase their CD4 Count and Suppression in Viral load and also helps them to continue their studies.

USAID, ACCELERATE-YRG CARE had identified Cheyutha WCBO as a capable organisation to run Adolescent Friendly Health Clinic who needs Intensive care services as our organization has been promoting the right level of cognizance when it comes to creating the needful level of awareness, specifically amongst the HIV infected children, adolescents and the Youth. At the same time, our Management feels that it is the need of the Day!! Keeping this parameter in mind, our organization has also associated with various organizations to provided quality and efficient services to the children; in this era we had partnered with Young Indian, GOONJ and Dr. Ranganath Rao sir Cheyutha WCBO Well wisher to support the camps. Coming to the significant part of the story, the Session favored in burgeoning the Confidence Levels amongst the Adolescents and at the same time and it was no less than the Ladder to the required Emotional and Moral Support.

Life Skills Sessions are an integral part of the development of any child. The Catchiest part of the story is that these Skills can be of the utmost significance for the Interpersonal growth of the Adolescent children.

## EDUCATION SUPPORT:

HIV infected and affected children .... Yes, do not they deserve Education? Well, the answer to this question is an absolute "YESS"!! After all, Education has been the Exact Pathway from the "No Man's Land" to the "Enlightenment and Awareness". At the scratch level this initiative commenced in the month of April 2022. At the First step itself, the Aadhar Cards as well as the Progress Reports of the HIV infected and affected children studying in different Schools and Colleges were collected along with their ART Information. Beyond this, CHEYUTHA WCB0 gave an Application Form to each of these Needy children. Furthermore, these Applications were screened, beyond which the priority was given to the **HIV Infected and Affected Orphans who are dependent on the Caregivers and Semi Orphans who are dependent on Single Parents**. The most Catchy part in this initiative is that it also included the Parents of HIV infected and affected children, who are suffering from multiple Align Diseases, however are unable to support their children's Education.

The inception of this story begins with ADP CSR Project which has contributed Rupees 2,82,000/- in the form of 31 Cheques, 16 Stationery Books, Bags and School Dress. Switching on to the profuse Modest Donations made, on one hand, Change Foundation sponsored a Lump sum Budget of Rupees 1,20,000/- for 12 students, while, on the other hand, Azim Prem Ji Foundation sponsored a combined value of Rupees 24,000/- for 4 students. At the same time, Mr. and Mrs. Usha Gummala donated Rupees 75,000/- for 10 students and the Joy Group donated Rupees 20,000/- for 4 students. Apart from this, it would be really amazing to know that many of the HIV infected mothers have come up together to collect an amount of Rupees 10,000/- to support the Education of One child. Last but not the least, Shri Praksah Reddy who is the Ex Chairman of IRCS has donated 1000 Long Note Books.

**1. Sponsorship for under privilege children:** District outreach officers Mrs. Jyothi and Mrs. Vinodha of Hyderabad and RRD had applied for sponsorship in women and child welfare department 23 applications out of that 7 children got sanctioned by Child Welfare Committee



- 2. ART Pensions:** Applied and followup for 46 members and sanctioned for 15 members from Hyderabad and Rangareddy
- 3. Government Housing Scheme:** Applied 51 members and throughly follow up by District Outreach officer and 10 got sanctioned
- 4. Hostel Admission:** This year we had joined 3 children in Gurukul Hostel and 1 girl along with her mother got admission in Agape Hostel

E. Shanthy and Kottaiah are the members of Cheyutha WCBO, they are having 3 daughters as Kottaiah is an addiction to alcohol and he is very careless towards his wife and 3 children. Mrs. Shanthy has to face lot of struggles due to his behavior as he beats his wife a lot when he's drunk. He use to drink 24/7. Mrs. Shanthy had requested Cheyutha WCBO for the support to join her elder daughter in the hostel, seeing her pathetic condition Cheyutha WCBO had spoke to Child Welfare Committee Hyderabad to Mrs. Sumitra madam and Mr. Bhaskar sir explained her condition and they have immediately gave her admission in Gurukul Hostel, Gajwal on Dt: 19th October 2022 in class 5th standard. Now Keerthana had joined in Gurukul Hostel studying well and now she and her mother are happy.

## LEGAL SERVICES:



**POSITIVE MARRIAGE:** With proper medical care and adherence to antiretroviral therapy, HIV positive individuals can marry and have healthy babies or adopt children. It is important to continue to promote awareness and fight the social stigma surrounding HIV to ensure that HIV positive individuals are treated with dignity and respect. 2022-2023 Cheyutha WCBO were able to felicitate 4 positive marriages.



**SUPPORT GROUP:** An Active Support Group Program, wherein, the HIV Infected Women are made to live Life on Hopes of Positivity!! 12 support group meetings were conducted at the premises of Cheyutha WCBO office. Total women registered in support group: 137 members and they were provided with low cost nutrition like: ½ kg Peanut, ½ kg Tile and ½ kg Jaggery which gives supplements like: (Iron, Calcium and Protein) not only have this but they also done monthly savings of Rs. 100 /- from their widow / ART pension on their individuals.



**VOLUNTEER FOR CHEYUTHA WCBO:** Total 25 women and 10 children are of age group below 35 years were trained on different aspects then and now they are active Volunteers and senses on belong to the organisation as they help in increase in the membership and help in conduct the events and as it is women organisation we get Men support whenever it is required and developing the second line leadership.

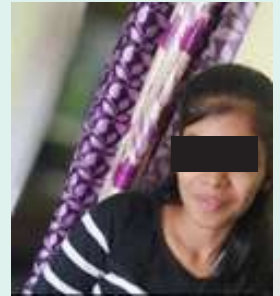




## 9.STORIES OF CHALLENGES AND CHANGE:

### Case Study: 1

Sanjana who is been HIV positive and semi Orphan she is only one HIV positive in the house when she was small she had Ear infection she had gone to RMP where she was treated for ear infection at the age of 13 years Sanjana father had expired due to heart attack and her mother only breadwinner of the family she is working in a company as a daily labour and she is been paid monthly Rs.6,000/- which was not sufficient to take care of the family meanwhile Sanjana was suffering with ear infection and she was suggested to go for operation in that investigations she came to know that she is HIV positive and they have not done for ear operation she was discriminated in Government hospital, Sanjana has come back to the house and she went for a treatment to Cherlapally LEPRO Society there she came to know about Cheyutha WCBO is working on HIV/AIDS she then referred to cheyutha WCBO and she has been enrolled for services and then she was supported by Mr.Vamshi Krishna and his team ADP who had been kind enough to support Sanjana with the Groceries and Education Support, since then Sanjana completed her S.S.C with 7.7 and Inter 88% and Degree with 78% and she has been given entrance exam for MSW and qualified in the entrance. Now Sanjana is 20 years and working as a case manager in ACCELERATE, YRG CARE for her kind of community children for the age group of 10-17 years.



### Case Study: 2

Renuka and Asha are Biological sisters. Their parents had expired due to AIDS. Moreover, these Girls became ART Defaulters. In the meantime, they were already residing with their Grandparents. By the time, they came up to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC; they were already diagnosed with Tuberculosis. Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC as the Role Player:

Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC came up with the inception of ART Medicines for these two sisters. Apart from

this, they also provided Nutritious Food and Treatment for OI's. The two Girls were on Regular follow up for ART. Both of these sisters have been found to gain weight in between November 2021 to February 2023. The Best part of the story is that they were Virally Unsuppressed when they had come to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC and now they are virally suppressed.

### Case Study: 3

Srinivas is an ART Defaulter along with Spine TB. When he came to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC, he was having a Lump on the back. After coming to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC, he was diagnosed with Tuberculosis and his Treatment was started at Chest Hospital. Beyond this, Srinivas was also re-initiated on ART. At the same time, his Lump had gone extremely large and Reddish and the lump was operated at Gandhi Hospital with lot of difficulty. However, because of the profuse Discharge of Blood and Puss, since government hospitals did not take this initiative of cleaning his operated Lump. The patient had to undergo Two months of incessant Dressing at ESI Hospital with the referral of Cheyutha WCBO. Fortunately, he is doing well, as if now and the wounds have healed. On one hand, his Appetite has increased and on the other hand, he has put on weight along with the regular consumption of ART Medicines.



### Case Study 4:

Ms. Tanisha (Name changed): 12 years old, a positive girl child, her both the parents are also HIV positive. As her father was an alcoholic, he use to abuse his own daughter, meanwhile to protect her daughter the mother came out of the house and took her daughter to her mother's place. Pavani and her daughter with the help of her elder brother had approached she team and Women wings even after the counseling from there, they couldn't saw any changes in the behavior of the father.



As they are taking their ART medication from Niloufer hospital, they had referred them to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC. After they approached Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC both the mother and child got counseled and enrolled in AFHC Clinic and mother in Cheyutha WCBO later Mrs. Pavani's elder brother told about the issues to the Project Director of Cheyutha WCBO, then the case was taken to the district legal service authority by the Cheyutha WCBO district outreach officer and the girl was taken to the Child Welfare Committee for the

hostel admission and the case was referred to Agape hostel along with the Cheyutha WCBO staff while the daughter was getting admission Cheyutha WCBO staff had requested for the mother's shelter as she doesn't have protection, she was also burden to her brothers family. The concern was expressed Mrs. Pavani had qualification and experience as ANM soon she had got job and got an opportunity to work as hostel warden in Agape hostel. They were very much grateful to Cheyutha WCBO-Adolescent Friendly Health Clinic.

### Case Study 5:

Ms. Sana (Name change): 17 years old Adolescent who is also suffering with health issues as she was HIV positive and her both the parents are also HIV positive her father was in AIDS stage and Sana was Virally unsuppressed she had referred from OVC program YRG care to our AFHC and when she had come with all hope less as her family was not having any food to eat at least two time



HIV Disease we need to eat at least two time to maintain their Immunity system with ART medicine during the counseling we came to know that Ms.Sana had completed her 10th Grade and 10/10 GPA but due to finical constraints school management had not given her TC and 10th certificate ware she have to drop out from Education, her both the parents are HIV positive and her father is a bed ridden person and seriously ill.

Case manager had requested Cheyutha WCBO to provide her with nutrition and education support. As her school fee is pending, due to that she couldn't able to continue her Intermediate education. when she came to Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC she expressed her feelings and enthusiastic towards education and that's how she had also expressed to Dr.Subhash sir YRG Care and that's how she was granted for education support through sir and Cheyutha WCBO-AFHC and finally she has re-started her education. She was joined in Intermediate BIPC. She is also very much bold enough to talk about herself and she promised herself to motivate her peers for treatment adherence and also how to overcome critical situations, she is one of our identified treatment champion also.

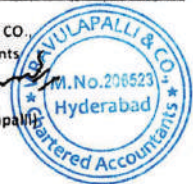

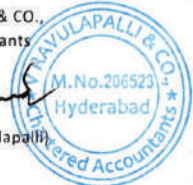

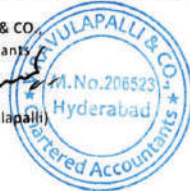
